

CRAPS WITH CARDS

A New Twist On An Old Favorite.

Sycuan Craps is an exciting new game that uses cards to determine which number is "rolled". Adding excitement to the game, players participate in the fun by rolling the dice to determine the cards to be used for each roll.

COMMON BETS

Pass Line

At the beginning of each session, the first two cards dealt is known as the "come out roll". A puck, printed with the word "off" is placed on the layout. At this time, all bets on the Pass Line win on a 7 or 11, and lose on 2, 3, and 12.

Pass Line bets will continue to win or lose on these numbers until any other number (4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10) is totaled on the two cards dealt. When the total of the two cards is any of these numbers it becomes the point and is marked with the puck, which will be placed in the "On" position.

COME BET

Once a point has been established, players may bet in the "Come". The Come can be thought of as a perpetual Pass Line, whereby bets win on 7 and 11, and lose on 2, 3, and 12. If the two cards dealt total any other number (4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10) that number becomes the point for these bets.

The bets will be moved into the number that the two cards dealt total. They will win if that number is repeated, and lose if the two cards total a 7.

PLACE BET

The place bet on one of the numbers (4, 5, 6, 8, 9, or 10) is a bet that the number (the total of the two cards dealt) will be dealt before a 7. While the puck is in the "On" position, these bets will win every time the numbers is totaled by the two cards dealt. They lose if the two cards dealt total a 7. Bets on the 4, 5, 9, and 10 should be made in multiples of \$5. Bets on the 6 and 8 should be made in multiples of \$6.

THE PAYOFF SCHEDULES FOR PLACE BETS ARE:

NUMBER ODDS

4 or 10	9-to-5
5 or 9	7-to-5
6 or 8	7-to-6

PROPOSITION BETS

A "single roll" bet is the total of the two cards dealt.

HORN BETS

A horn bet wins on a 2, 3, 11 or 12. It wins or loses on a "single roll" (two dealt cards).

HARD WAYS

Hard ways are not a "single roll" bet. A hard way is a bet that the selected number will roll with double before the numbers is rolled any other way or a 7 is rolled. Hard 6 and 8 pay 9-to-1. Hard 4 and 10 pay 7-to-1.

ANY 7

Any 7 is a "single roll" bet that wins if the two cards total a 7. It pays 4-to-1.

FIELD BET

The field is a "single roll" bet. It wins 1-to-1 if 3, 4, 9, 10, and 11 is the total of the cards dealt. It wins 2-to-1 if 2 is the total of the 2 cards dealt and 3-to-1 if 12 is one of the 2 cards dealt.
