

Three Card Poker progressive is an exciting stud poker game. You may bet against the dealer, bet on the value of your own three card hand, or bet both. Bonus payouts may be had for certain hands when wagering against the dealer.

PAIR PLUSSM SIDE BET

If your hand contains a pair or better, you win!

PAIR PLUS HAND PAYS
Straight Flush 40 to 1
Three-of-a-kind 30 to 1
Straight6 to 1
Flush 3 to 1
Pair1 to 1

ANTE

Ante lets you play against the dealer's hand. It's just your cards against the dealer's. If you make an **Ante** bet and like your hand you must place an equal wager on the **Play** spot. It's your three-card poker hand against the dealer's three card poker hand and the best hand wins. If you win, **Ante** and **Play** pay 1 to 1. If the dealer wins, **Ante** and **Play** lose. Dealer qualifies with a Queen High or Better. If the dealer does not qualify, the **Play** bet is refunded and the **Ante** pays 1 to 1.

TO PLAY BOTH PAIR PLUS AND ANTE

It's you and your cards for a pair or better and it's you against the dealer for the best three-card poker hand. You must also make the play wager or you will forfeit the ante wager.

ANTE BONUS

If you make the **Ante** and **Play** wagers, you may win a bonus payout even if the dealer doesn't qualify and even if the dealer's hand beats your hand. Players must have one of the following hands to receive the Ante Bonus payout.

HAND	PAYS
Straight Flush Three-of-a-kind Straight	4 to 1

PROGRESSIVE PAYOUTS

Progressive winners are determined from the player's three cards, and two community cards that are used just for determining progressive winners. The optional progressive bet qualifies you for part or all of the incrementing jackpot. See paytable for odds. Folded hands do not qualify for payouts on the progressive wager.
